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# 2023 MUI Stats Through April

### **Overall numbers**

- 519 categories filed. Currently on pace for 1,557 categories filed this year. This projection has reduced since the end of March
  - Average of 130 per month (down from March's Avg of 134)
  - Average was 117 per month for 2022.
  - Daily Average for opened MUI in April was 5.5 & this was by far the lowest avg. YTD
- The 469<sup>th</sup> MUI was filed on 4/30/23 this year. In 2022, the 469<sup>th</sup> MUI was filed on 5/12/22. Even though we slowed down substantially as compared to the end of March, we're ahead by a few more days from the difference last month.
- By Category:
  - Category A 38.3% (decrease of 2.5%)
  - Category B 22.4% (increase of 0.6%)
  - Category C 39.3% (increase of 2.3%)
- In comparing the distribution of Category A, B and C's for the month of April, a substantial difference was seen in A's and C's from Q1.
  - $\circ$  Category A's were 29.1% of April's total, down over 11% from the Q1 average
  - Category C's were 47.3% of April's total, up 10% from the Q1 average

### **Notes on the Monthly Data**

- There was a significant decrease in the number of overall categories in April, especially in Category A.
- Only 6 Physical Abuse filed in April, as compared to a previous monthly average of 11. Neglect also down with 8 filed in April compared to a previous monthly average of 12.7.
- Most other categories were either similar to prior monthly averages or slightly less.
- Among Category A's, Misappropriation and Verbal Abuse are our highest categories both at 49, followed by Neglect at 46 and Physical Abuse at 39.
- Verbal Abuse, Neglect and Misappropriation are on pace to exceed 2022.

## **Topics being monitored**

- Supervision Neglect
  - 22 incidents
  - No 2023 trend with any specific provider
  - DSPs not providing ISP defined supervision in the home continues to be the most prominent issue
  - One individual has 3 supervision neglects & one other has two. The rest are singular occurrences
  - 15/16 completed investigations have been substantiated.
  - Matching 2022's overall pace so far
- Attempted Suicide
  - 8 incidents
  - 8 different individuals
  - 1 associated Neglect (substantiated)
  - Slight reduction in pace as compared to 2022
